A former publicity director at Simon and Schuster, Musiker's motivation behind writing a book of her own was the revelation that one smartly tossed sports fact is worth as much in a boardroom full of men as a year's worth of equally smart conversation. A casual, "Jerry Rice was even more amazing than usual," and Musiker was no longer the invisible woman. "Then the walls came tumbling down," she writes. Ladies, read the title carefully: this is not a book for smart girls who played sports, love sports, follow sports or have an interest in sports deeper than their lipstick shade. Those with more than a passing interest in the sports she covers—football, baseball, basketball, boxing, hockey, golf and car racing—may take offense to tips like, "Set your sights on a hottie and root for him and his team." But for the smart girl with a desire to know of what her male counterparts speak, Musiker's is a book to study prior to the company golf outing. (Don't know what a dogleg is? You will now.) Women will be comforted by Musiker's "I'm-learning-along-with-you" writing style, but don't be fooled: her research and descriptions of the game, as well as useful sections on "Players to Know," movies to watch, books to read and great moments in sports are top notch. Call it a condensed version of the Sports For Dummies line of books. Only here, Musiker has replaced "Dummies" with "Girls." Smart girls.

Armed with both facts and humor, Musiker has written what could become an invaluable resource for football, baseball, hockey, basketball, golf, boxing, or NASCAR widows. It's a good thing she is a sports fan herself, so there's none of that arm's-length ickiness that often drips from advice books that proffer, "Just pretend to be interested, girls!" Instead, Musiker presents valuable information for sports-weary women, encouraging them to give spectator sports a try--they might just love them like she does. Each sport gets its own chapter, subdivided by three sections: "Here's How It Works," "Players You Need to Know," and a glossary. Helpful sidebars—"The Gipper Revealed" (explaining the "win one for the Gipper" allusion and its Ronald Reagan connection) or "Baseball Records Cheat Sheet" (great for cocktail party opening lines)--make the book browsable and fun to use. Sure, some might quibble about certain overlooked points (How can you talk basketball or football without understanding the time-out?), but all in all, this guidebook will be a welcome helper for millions of sports-shy women (and men). *Mary Frances Wilkens*
