In this substantial biography, written with Wallace's cooperation, Leshner's portrayal of the four-term Alabama governor as "the dominant and most important issue maker of his time," shifting national campaign rhetoric to the right, is convincing, if overstated. The author, a former Newsweek correspondent, traces the origins and development of Wallace's powers of hucksterism and his need for an audience, laying out his "extraordinary racial schizophrenia": because of his political ambition, Wallace allowed his populist support for bills that often benefited blacks to be overshadowed by his racist political positioning. Thus Leshner recounts the twists and turns of Wallace's many campaigns, including his epochal third-party presidential bid in 1968 and his defense of segregation. Leshner points out that Wallace's populism, unlike that of Reaganite Republicans, took on the rich, and tells how Wallace, crippled in a 1972 assassination attempt, recovered a humanity that led him to make public apologies for his racism. Though this book is an essential resource and Leshner writes well, readers seeking an account of Wallace's strange magnetism should also consult Marshall Frady's 1972 minibiography, *Wallace*.

Former Alabama governor and presidential candidate George Wallace is remembered primarily for his opposition to racial integration in the 1960s and 1970s. Journalist Leshner's biography provides ample documentation, if any is needed, that Wallace encouraged racism and benefited from it in his campaigns. However, Leshner also argues that Wallace recognized and tapped a strain of populist sentiment in American politics that later politicians as different as Ronald Reagan and Bill Clinton successfully used to further their own political careers. Moreover, he asserts that "every successful presidential campaign from 1968 through 1992 was founded on popular issues and rhetoric first identified and articulated by Wallace." This may be an exaggeration, but it is true that many contemporary politicians have more in common with Wallace than they would be comfortable acknowledging. The most comprehensive biography available of Wallace; highly recommended for academic libraries.

As Leshner illustrates, the reality of Wallace was far more complicated. Leshner views him as a fascinating, charismatic, and enigmatic political figure whose influence on national politics

far exceeded his modest vote totals in the elections of 1968 and 1972. Leshner traces Wallace's personal and political development from his youth in dirt-poor Barbour County to his metamorphosis into a respected southern moderate of the New South. Along the way, Leshner reveals a man of toughness, competitive fire, and a surprising capacity for growth and compassion. Above all, Leshner's Wallace is a product of the Deep South, with its sense of pride and victimization always present in Wallace's personal and political psyche.
